Please take some time to review the following checklist so that you and your child(ren) are ready for a successful school year. As always, feel free to call or email if you have questions.

- Solar Eclipse Permission Form Needed for First Day of School for Grades 1 through 8. There will be a solar eclipse around 2:44pm on our first day of school. We have ordered special viewing glasses and would like to allow children in grades 1 through 8 to view the eclipse. Click here to download and print a permission form. Please send this form the very first day of school, August 21. Please also talk with your child in advance about the extreme importance of only viewing the eclipse while wearing the protective glasses.
 - Sign up for Parents Web if you do not already have an account (see attached instructions).
 - Purchase your child's PE Uniform visit our website to pre-order (www.allsaintsric.org go to the Parents Tab/Forms & Info/PE uniforms). You can pre-pay and your child's P.E. uniform will be delivered to him/her the first week of school.
 - For information on school uniforms go to the Parents Tab/Forms & Info/Uniform Policy.
 Children should wear regular school uniforms the week of August 21st. They should wear PE uniforms on their assigned day beginning Aug 28th.

- Children will need to bring a lunch to school. All Saints will offer a simple lunch for \$2 per child on Tuesdays and Wednesdays each week beginning on September 5. Tuesday is chicken nuggets and fries. Wednesday is pizza and fries. Fruit will be available as donated. Ice cream can be pre-ordered for Fridays. Milk may be pre-ordered for everyday or for Tuesdays and Wednesdays only. All lunch, milk, and ice cream orders must be made through Parents Web (instructions are attached). The system will be set to start accepting orders on August 7, 2017. We will be able to help you set up your account and place your order in the office if assistance is needed. If you do not have a debit or credit card, please contact Mrs. Coleman or Mrs. Leon for assistance (804-329-7524).
- School Supply lists can be found at <u>www.allsaintsric.org/forms.htm</u>. You can order with one click through Classbundl. Feel free to divide the supplies and send in half on day 1 of school and half on day 2. Supplies may also be dropped off between 9am and 2pm August 14 through August 18.
- After-school program (ASP): If your child will attend ASP, please complete the student data form found at www.allsaintsric.org/forms.htm and send it with your child on the first day of school. Our after school program is certified through the Virginia Department of Social Services and student data forms are a must for program compliance.
- Plan to read the Wednesday News each week as this is how the school keeps you
 informed about important events and procedures. The Wednesday News comes to you
 via email. Check the directory in Parent Web to be sure the school has your up-to-date
 information. We also send home forms (especially those that require signatures) in a
 Wednesday folder. Students should return the Wednesday folder each Thursday.
- Summer Reading Logs for grades K 4 and Summer Reading Reports for grades 5 to 8 are due the first day of school.
- Mark your calendars as applicable.
 - Parent Work Night Tuesday, August 8, 2017, 6 9pm. Calling all parents All Saints is hosting a *Painting and Cleaning Parent Work Night!* Volunteers are needed to paint walls and clean classrooms. Introducing Parent Web

Great news parents! All Saints introduces Parent Web. You can accomplish the following tasks with Parent Web:

- View your child's(ren's) after school account on-line
- Pay your after-school bill on-line through Paypal or via credit card. Payments should be made by Wednesday following the week of attendance.
- Pre-order lunch, milk and ice cream
- · View your child's report card and attendance record
- View an All Saints family directory

Please note that not all options that are possible through Parent Web are currently active for All Saints parents. The school will consider other options in the future.

Directions for setting up your Parent Web account.

Parent Web is EASY!

Visit <u>www.renweb.com</u>. ****To set up your account, you must use a laptop or desktop computer. The setup option does not appear on a cell phone. You do not need to purchase the App offered. Once set up, all functions of Parent Web work from the internet on your cell phone. Please call or visit the school office if you have difficulties.

Lunch, Milk and Ice-cream

Students must bring a lunch to school most school days. Since there will not be microwaves or refrigerator space available, please do not send lunches that need to be heated or refrigerated. We recommend you place small freezer packs in your child's lunch box to keep food cool.

All Saints will offer a simple lunch for \$2 per child on Tuesdays and Wednesdays each week beginning on September 5. Tuesday is chicken nuggets and fries. Wednesday is pizza and fries. Fruit will be available as donated.

Beginning the week of September 5, ice cream can be pre-ordered for Fridays and milk may be pre-ordered for everyday or for Tuesdays and Wednesdays only.

All items must be pre-ordered and paid for using your Parent Web account. With pre-purchase, we are able to offer items at significant discounts (milk is 50 cents per day and ice cream is 60 cents). You may choose to pay by the month, semester or full year. If a child is absent, we are not able to reimburse or extend the time period. If you do not have a credit card, debit card, or Paypal account or need assistance with Parent Web, please contact Ms. Coleman in our school office.

To order lunch, milk, and/or ice cream:

- Log into your ParentWeb account (If you do not have an account, directions are provided on the reverse side of this page to create an account.)
- Click the down arrow next to Student Information and choose Lunch
- On the right side of the screen, choose *Create Web Order*
- You will see options to purchase chicken nuggets and pizza for one month at a time. You can choose to order just for one month or several months or select all options to pay for the rest of the year. There are also options for purchasing milk and ice cream. You put a 1 in the box to select an option.
- When you are done selecting, click on *Order Items* at the bottom right
- Enter your payment information and submit

Orders for each month must be placed by the 25th of the previous month. For example, orders for September must be placed by August 25th. The system will be set to accept orders beginning 8/7/17.
