Parents, are you ready for school?

New family orientation – Wednesday, August 15th, 6pm – 7pm. All new families are invited to learn "survival" skills for a successful year at All Saints.

Orientation Day is Monday, August 20th <u>Teacher presentations</u>: Pre-K – Grade 4: 9am or 1pm Grade 5 and any new middle schoolers: 9am Grades 6 to 8: 1pm

First day of school is Tuesday, August 21st, 7:50am

- Purchase your child's **PE Uniform**: <u>https://www.allsaintsric.org/parents/uniforms/</u> Pre-pay online and your child's P.E. uniform will be delivered to him/her the first week of school.
- For information on **school uniforms** <u>https://www.allsaintsric.org/parents/uniforms</u>/ Children should wear regular school uniforms the week of August 21st. They should wear PE uniforms on their assigned day beginning Aug 27th. Homeroom teachers will communicate assigned PE days at orientation.
- **Children will need to bring a lunch to school**. See <u>https://www.allsaintsric.org/parents/lunch-info/</u> All Saints will offer a simple lunch for \$2 per child on Tuesdays and Thursdays each week beginning on September 5th. Tuesday is chicken nuggets and fries. Wednesday is pizza and salad. Fruit will

be available as donated. Ice cream can be pre-ordered for Fridays. Milk may be pre-ordered for everyday or for Tuesdays and Thursdays only. All lunch, milk, and ice cream orders must be made through Parents Web. We will be able to help you set up your account and place your order in the office if assistance is needed. If you do not have a debit or credit card, please contact Mrs. Coleman in the school office for assistance (804-329-7524).

- After-school program (ASP): If your child will attend ASP, please complete the student data form at https://www.allsaintsric.org/wp-content/uploads/2018/06/Student-Data-After-School-Form-2018-19.pdf and send it with your child on the first day of school. Our after school program is certified through the Virginia Department of Social Services and student data forms are a must for program compliance.
- Plan to read the **Wednesday News** each week as this is how the school keeps you informed about important events and procedures. The Wednesday News comes to you via email. Check the directory in Parent Web to be sure the school has your up-to-date information. We also send home forms (especially those that require signatures) in a Wednesday folder. Students should return the Wednesday folder each Thursday.
