New Roles, New Faces, Returning Faces

With the departure of Mrs. Wallin, faculty and staff are taking on additional responsibilities to ensure the school runs smoothly. Ms. Coleman with her many years of experience is instrumental in day-to-day operations. To help Ms. Coleman have more time for administrative duties, we welcomed a new part-time receptionist, Ms. Dorothy Smith at the beginning of January. Ms. Smith will be working in the front office from 7:45 to 10:45 am each school morning.

Ms. Jenni Ellis, who continues at 30 hours a week as the Support for Accreditation and Academic Services, is responsible for coordination of performance series testing and data analysis, coordinating progress reports and report cards, assisting with accreditation and overseeing the volunteer program. Additionally, she will assist with teacher evaluations, and managing the tutoring program. In the event Mr. Soistman is absent or unavailable, she will serve as head of school until he is available.

Lastly, we welcome back Mrs. Carolyn Chambers who worked at All Saints for over a decade in the early 2000's. She is providing temporary, part-time support in the office while Mrs. Judy Brown is out on medical leave.

Nuevos roles, nuevas caras, caras que vuelven

Con la partida de la Sra. Wallin, los profesores y el personal están asumiendo responsabilidades adicionales para garantizar que la escuela funcione sin problemas. La Sra. Coleman, con sus muchos años de experiencia, es fundamental para dirigir la escuela. Para ayudar a la Sra. Coleman a tener más tiempo para realizar otras tareas administrativas, le dimos la bienvenida a una nueva recepcionista de medio tiempo, la Sra. Dorothy Smith. La Sra. Smith trabajará en la oficina principal de 7:45 a 10:45 am cada mañana.

Además, La Sra. Jenni Ellis, que continúa 30 horas a la semana como Apoyo para Acreditación y Servicios Académicos, es responsable de coordinar las pruebas de rendimiento y análisis de datos, coordinar informes de progreso y de calificaciones, ayudar con la acreditación y supervisar el programa de voluntarios. Además, ayudará con las evaluaciones de los maestros y con la gestión del programa de tutoría. En caso de que el Sr. Soistman esté ausente o no esté disponible, ella se desempeñará como directora de la escuela hasta que él esté disponible.

Por último, damos la bienvenida de nuevo a la Sra. Carolyn Chambers, que trabajó en All Saints por más de 10 años. Ella está proporcionando apoyo temporal, a tiempo parcial en la oficina hasta cuando vuelva Sra. Judy Brown que está ausente debido unas condiciones medicales.
